



About your Olfi Camera



1. Remove the camera from the waterproof case.








2. Insert a Class 10 or higher MicroSD card (up to 64GB). Format memory card before first use.





3. Remove the battery cover and insert the battery.







4. Charge the battery using the USB cable provided for 8 hours before first use.









Mounting

Flat Surface Mounting



Curved Surface Mounting



Applying 3M Base Mounts


Ensure adhesive mounts are applied to clean, smooth surfaces at room temperature. It is advisable to leave them at least 24 hours before first use. To remove, apply gentle heat with a hair dryer then peel off.

Power On/Off

1. Press and hold the Power/Mode (b) button for 3 seconds.



2. The LCD screen will power on, show the welcome screen (Olfi logo) and then the home screen.



3. To power off press and hold the Power/Mode (b) button for 2 seconds.







Selecting Camera Mode

1. With the camera turned on press the Power/Mode (b) button to toggle between video/stills mode.



Capturing Video/Stills

1. Select camera mode then press the Shutter button to start/stop recording or take a photo.

Adjusting Camera Settings

- 1. Press either of the Settings buttons (Up/Down) to toggle through the menu.
- 2. Press the Shutter button to enter the required setting.
- 3. Use the Settings buttons (Up/Down) to cycle through the options.
- 4. Press the Shutter button to select.
- 5. Press the Power/Mode button to return to the home screen.



Video Resolution 4K @ 24fps 2.5K @ 30fps 1080p @ 30/60fps 720p @ 120fps VGA @ 30fps



Videolapse Automatically creates a time lapse video from images taken at set intervals of 0.5, 1, 3, 5, 10, and 30 seconds.



Loop Record Continuously records in 5 minute sections, overwriting the oldest files when the memory card is full. This mode is ideal for evidential use.



USB Auto On With this feature selected, the camera will power on and start recording when power is detected.



HDR HDR (High Dynamic Range) captures more detail in the image's highlights and shadows.



Photo Resolution 16MP (4609×3456 pixels) 8MP (3264×2448 pixels) 5MP (2592×1944 pixels)



Takes 11 photos in 1 second.



Timelapse Takes a sequence of photos over set intervals of 1, 3, 5, 10, and 30 seconds.



ISO Adjusting this setting is recommended for professional users. Limits can be set at 100, 400 and 1600 ISO.



Sharpness Choose from High, Medium and Low sharpness settings



Colour Choose from Standard and Vivid colour profiles.



Exposure Values Choose from High, Medium and Low exposure values.



Metering Adjust metering mode between; Average, Center and Spot metering.



Date Rate Increase or decrease video data rate (bit rate). Increasing bit rate will improve video quality, but use more storage per second.



Time/Date Stamp Adds a time and date stamp. This feature is recommended for evidential use only as the time stamp cannot be removed from the file



TV Mode TV output mode: PAL/NTSC.



Light Frequency Adjust light frequency between 50HZ and 60HZ to reduce flicker from artificial lighting.



Remove Fisheye Automatically reduces the "Fisheye" effect visible when field of view is set to Wide.

USB Auto Off Camera will automatically power off when the USB power supply is cut. Combine this feature with "USB Auto On", "Time Stamp" and "Loop" for the perfect evidential setup.



FOV - Field of View Field of view can be adjusted between Narrow, Medium and Wide modes.



Format Memory Card Deletes contents of memory card.

Auto Power Off When selected the camera will power off after 1 minute of standby time.



Firmware Version Check the official Olfi website for firmware updates. (www.olfi.co.uk)



*Wi-Fi can also be turned on by pressing the 'Up' settings button for 2 seconds. To turn off press either of the Settings buttons.

NOTE: Wi-Fi cannot be turned on when video resolution is set to 4K.



Non-Waterproof Back Door IMPORTANT:


Only use for dry activities. Also provides improved audio.



Waterproof Back Door

Ensure you use for shooting underwater, watersports or in wet conditions. With the waterproof back door fitted the camera can be submersed up to 30M underwater.

Review and Share

Computer

Connect the camera to your computer with the USB cable provided; the camera's LCD screen will show a USB icon. PC users open 'My Computer', Mac users navigate to 'Finder', the camera should be recognised as a removable disk; double click to open. Open the 'OLFI' folder to access your files.



TV

Connect your camera to a TV with a micro HDMI cable (sold separately). Power on the camera and choose the desired HDMI input on the TV, the TV will then display a live preview. Press the Power/Mode button until the HDMI logo appears on the camera LCD screen. You can now view content stored on the camera's memory card.



Smart Devices

Use the Olfi App to review and share your files on a smartphone or tablet. App available from the App Store and Google Play Store (may not be available at time of print).



Olfi App

The Olfi App will allow you to control your camera remotely using a smartphone, tablet or compatible wearable. Review and share your files across your favourite social media platforms.

Download the Olfi App and open it on your smart device. Follow the app's on-screen instructions to connect your camera.

As a default your Olfi's Wi-Fi password is '12345678'.
